## January 27, 2026 | Bolingbrook, IL | Federal Agents Arrest Bolingbrook Man

On January 27th at approximately 7:42 AM officers were dispatched to the Bolingbrook Police Department lobby to meet with a complainant reference an encounter with law enforcement.

Responding officers were met by Federal Law Enforcement Agents who had just taken the 40-year-old man into custody for an incident that occurred prior to the man's arrival at our department. The agents were conducting targeted immigration enforcement at a residence without the knowledge or assistance of the Bolingbrook Police Department.

According to the involved agents, Federal Law Enforcement was present on Hywood Lane in Bolingbrook conducting targeted immigration enforcement at a residence. During their investigation, agents came into contact with the 40-year-old male who was seated in a nearby pick-up truck.

The agents stated that the man was ordered to identify himself and to exit the vehicle. The male refused the agents' orders and proceeded to drive through the grass before intentionally ramming an agent's vehicle head-on, while it was parked with its emergency lights activated.

The male fled the scene in his vehicle and relocated to the Bolingbrook Police Department to report the encounter, where he was taken into custody by the Federal Agents prior to the arrival of our officers.

The Bolingbrook Police Department's only involvement was filing a report for Criminal Damage to Property for the alleged intentional vehicular collision that occurred on Hywood Lane.
