



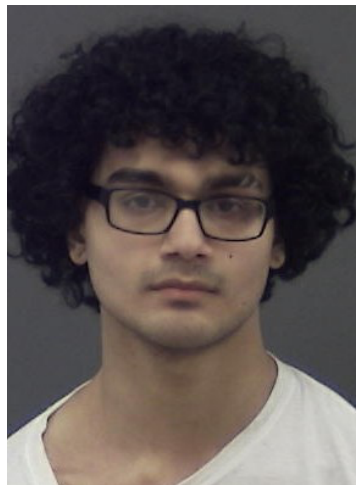

February 1, 2026 | Bolingbrook, IL | Noise Complaints Lead to Firearm Arrests of Skokie and Chicago Men

On January 31st, at approximately 9:41 PM the Bolingbrook Police Department responded to the 700 block of Hawthorne Court for multiple reports of a loud party with underage alcohol consumption. While dispersing the party, Officers from the Problem Oriented Policing unit encountered Muhammad T. Nadeem of Skokie (18) and five juveniles nearby.

A brief investigation revealed two (2) loaded firearms and an amount of cannabis. Nadeem and five (5) juveniles were arrested. Nadeem was charged with the following offenses:

- Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (2)
- Unlawful Use of a Weapon
- Unlawful Possession of Firearm
- Unlawful Possession of Ammunition
- Possession of a Concealed Firearm

Later during the same shift, Patrol Officers responded to Brookside Court for a report of a theft and a loud party. The suspects from the theft were located and Angelo Albert of Chicago (18) was discovered to be in possession of a loaded firearm. He was charged with the following offense:
