This weekend, the Bolingbrook Police Department is joining the Illinois State Police and local law enforcement by participating in the Illinois Department of Transportation's Super Bowl Traffic Safety Campaign.

From February 6th – February 9th our department will step up enforcement of occupant protection laws to help ensure the safety of all passengers in motor vehicles traveling in our community during Super Bowl weekend.

We want to increase public awareness of the dangers associated with not buckling up. Seat belts are saving lives. One of the safest choices drivers and passengers can make is to buckle up-every trip, every time, and double check all child safety seats! No matter where you are seated in a vehicle, you must wear a seat belt. Distracted driving and speeding will get you a citation.

And if your Super Bowl celebration involves alcohol or cannabis, plan for a safe ride home with a sober driver. If you're hosting the party, take care of the designated drivers. Fans don't let fans drive impaired.
