The Village of Bolingbrook Police Department is now accepting applications for the position of Entry Level Police Officer.

The testing process will be as follows:

APPLICATION AVAILABLE: Friday, November 15, 2024

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Friday, January 03, 2025, at 5:00 pm (CST)

- Provide certification of passing the Peace Officer Wellness Evaluation Report (P.O.W.E.R. Test) at the time of written examination.
- A written examination will be administered **Saturday, January 11, 2025. Check-in will begin at 8:00 am, with doors being locked promptly at 9:00 am for the test to begin at:**

- All applicants must be US citizens.
- All applicants must be **at least 20 years of age and no more than 34 years of age by January 03, 2025**, except as otherwise provided by Illinois Statute.
- All applicants must provide proof of successful completion of the P.O.W.E.R. Test. Only the Triton Criminal Justice Program P.O.W.E.R. Test Card, Joliet Junior College P.O.W.E.R. Test Card or NIPSTA Power Test Card will be accepted.
- Residency within 30-mile radius of Bolingbrook required within 18 months of appointment.
- Minimum 60 college credit hours from accredited college or university required. **Military service, work-related training, and work-related certifications may be considered in lieu of or in combination with college credit.**

Candidates must submit copies of the following with their applications (reference complete list with application):
